

## **Presentation of the IUT Colmar**

The University Institute of Technology of Colmar was created in 1968.  
It comprises 6 departments delivering 6 diplomas ( DUTs) in initial education:

- Law engineering
- Biological engineering
- Hygiene security and environment
- Telecommunications and network engineering
- Marketing and commerce
- Thermal engineering

It has also 10 Professional Bachelors:

- Assistance in insurance and financial services
- Collecting, managing and exploiting agronomy data
- Security of property and people
- Wine and commerce
- Integrating data and voice systems in corporations
- The professional sector of Property and estate
- Commercial technicians
- Administration and security of networks
- Technician in molecular and cellular biology (under accreditation process)

It has nearly 1400 students

The Colmar IUT owns 3 laboratories or research teams:

- CERDACC: European law research centre on collective accidents and catastrophes
- GRTC: Research group on telecommunication
- GRPHE: Research group on high energy physics (laboratory of fundamental research, something unusual in IUTs).

The first two teams work on research contracts and CERDACC is regularly required for national expertise missions.

The 42 lecturers and professors of the IUT work in 14 different laboratories

The IUT is a key local and regional actor in the domains of education and research.

Through its actions in education research and technology transfer it has become an indispensable partner of the industrial and economic sector.
